Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are very excited to inform you of our Grade Retreats! **This letter contains vital information regarding the retreats so please read carefully.**

Dates: Wednesday, October 4 to Friday, October, 6, 2023

Departure and Arrival: Buses will depart from Eden High School on Wednesday at 8:45am and will arrive back at the school on Friday at 2:45pm. **Please have your child at Eden no later than 8:20am on the day of departure. Please meet at the “double staircase” entrance.**

Location: Camp Crossroads 1224 E. Bay Rd. Torrance, On. POC 1MO (705) 762-3111

Cost: \$275.00 and forms are due on Friday, June 9 by 3:00pm in the SLC Office. Forms received after this date will be placed on a waiting list. The registration fee covers accommodations, transportation, meals and activities. It does not cover a planned stop for lunch on the way to camp. Students will pay for their own meal. **PLEASE MAKE CHEQUES PAYABLE TO “EDEN SLC” or you can pay via e-transfer using the email: giving.slceden@gmail.com.**

Note: As we have planning costs, late cancellations affect our budget, so there is a new schedule concerning non-refundable deposits and is as follows:

Cancellations on or before:

June 30 will receive a **full refund.**

September 5 will receive a **\$100.00 refund.**

Any cancellations after **September 5** will receive a **\$50.00 refund.**

Also, our Safe Place Policy dictates a specific leader/student ratio, so our volunteer availability will determine how many students we can accommodate. Therefore, retreat forms will be **“time stamped” and in the event of a lack of volunteers, we will determine student eligibility on a first come/first serve basis.**

On another note, we will be offering canoeing/kayaking as an activity. It's a great opportunity for students to experience the outdoors in this way. As per DSBN regulations, each student participating will be required to complete a standard swim test and results will be given to school administration. The swim test will happen onsite at Camp Crossroads. Should your child not complete the swim test, an alternate activity will be provided. A fully certified lifeguard will be on duty and every participant will be required to wear a certified PFD.

Regarding cellphones and technology, our policy is to have cabin leaders collect cellphones during the orientation at the retreat. We believe that the opportunity to “disconnect” from social media on retreats is important as it places a value on experiencing new things and engaging with people personally. Cabin leaders will wake students up at the appropriate time so phones will not be needed as alarm clocks. As for retreat photos, the SLC can post photos for students to download and phones will be returned at the end of the retreat with enough time to take pictures with friends.

As a Spiritual Life Centre, we are excited about connecting with students and offering our program at Eden High School! We consider it a privilege to encourage and support students as they grow into who they are and who God has made them to be! We understand the challenges of high school life, and we work hard to help them feel welcome and supported. Before any student is allowed to attend the retreat, the following form must be read and signed by both the student and parent/legal guardian and returned with payment to the Spiritual Life Centre by the deadline.

While we anticipate that our students will exceed our expectations, should situations requiring discipline arise, parents will be notified, and if necessary, asked to pick up their child. In addition, if your son/daughter damages SLC or Camp Crossroads property, you will be liable for the cost to repair or replace the damaged item(s).

The following items are **NOT** welcome on retreats:

- * **alcohol**
- * **any tobacco products or vaping items.**
- * **illegal drugs (students requiring medication must notify an SLC member)**
- * **fireworks, firearms, lighters, weapons of any kind**
- * **electronics of any kind. Cell phones will be given to cabin leaders upon arriving at camp.**

Our hope is that our students will continue to respect and honour the volunteers who give of their time to build relationships with them, recognizing that disrespect is inappropriate. We will hold our students to the following expectations:

- * **prompt attendance at all activities**
- * **proper meal etiquette**
- * **proper bus etiquette**
- * **respecting our “lights out” policy**
- * **respect for those in leadership**
- * **respect for fellow students**
- * **recognizing that students are only allowed to enter their assigned cabin.**
